Giving you regular dental advice to help you take care of your teeth and gums should reduce the need for dental treatment.

We also offer intravenous sedation to help nervous patients who are anxious about receiving dental treatment.

Appointments

Telephone reception on 01236 749756 or call in person to make an appointment.

You will receive appointments for regular check-ups via text reminder or via letter in post. You will be provided only one reminder.

You will receive a text message reminder of your dental appointment 2 days before the date of you appointment.

If you are unable to keep an appointment, please give us at least 24 hours' notice. Please note that if you miss an appointment, without providing prior notice, a charge will be made. The practice can provide a cancellation policy document on charges.

Emergency and Out-Of-Hours Care

If you have a dental emergency telephone reception, where possible, during opening hours. You will then be given an appointment in a time-frame that is appropriate to your needs. If you are deemed to require emergency care, you will be given advice to help manage the symptoms and you will be seen within 24 hours. If you have a dental emergency when the practice is not open, telephone reception and a recorded message will give details of our out-of-hours' service. Advice can be given over the phone by contacting NHS24 on 111. Weekend emergencies may be given an appointment at Wishaw General Hospital via NHS24 if deemed appropriate.

Care and Treatment

 Preventative treatments including examinations, radiographs, oral hygiene advice, scale and polish, gum treatments and mouthquards.





- Restorative treatments including amalgam fillings (silver), composite fillings (white), crowns, bridges, veneers, root canal fillings & restorations on implants (once implant placed).
- Prosthetics (dentures) both NHS and Private, acrylic and cobalt chrome.
- Cosmetic dentistry including tooth whitening (over 18), white fillings, and metal free crowns, bridges and veneers.

Charges

Any treatment offered (either NHS or private) will be estimated, discussed and agreed with you in advance.

Private patients can choose to opt for finance payment plan that allows you to spread the cost of your dental care. Ask at reception for more details.

Charges for common procedures are as follows (guidelines only):

- X-rays, from £2.88
- Scale and polish, £11.40
- Silver filling, from £7.76
- White fillings from £80.00
- Crown, from £112.60
- Root Canal Treatment, from £41.96
- Surgical Treatment, varies according to work needed

Payment can be made by cash, debit card or credit card.

If you in in receipt of benefits you may be entitled to free NHS dental treatment or with HC3 be assisted in paying your dental charges. Qualifying benefits are:

- Under 18
- 18 and in full time education
- Expecting a baby
- Had a baby in the last 12 months
- Tax credit with NHS exemption certificate
- Income related job seekers allowance
- Pension credit guaranteed credit
- Income related employment support allowance
- Universal Credit

If you qualify for free dental treatment at each check-up appointment you must bring along proof of exemption.





Interpreting services can be arranged via our reception team who can book an approved interpreter to facilitate your dental treatment for any patients who needs assistance with English.

Access and Facilities

The practice has no designated parking there is on street parking for disabled badge holders for a number of hours. Situated 200 yards away is a multi-storey car park where patients can park free of charge. There is a ground floor level surgery for disabled persons' use. Suitable corridors and doors. If you have any concerns about accessing our services telephone for advice.

We have a toilet adapted for use by disabled people.

We also have a children's play area with books and simple toys; this is not supervised and parents are responsible for their own children.

Directions

The Practice is located on Hallcraig Street in Airdrie town centre, beside St. Andrew's Hospice Shop. There are numerous buses which travel in to Airdrie and stop within 5 mins walk of the practice. Airdrie train station is located 10 mins walk away from the practice also.
